

Project Diary

Each learner will be expected to reflect upon their work and contribute each week to their personal project diary. Every week you will log comments about your personal performance and the performance of the group as you complete the various tasks and the project as a whole. The diary will allow you to reflect on your language skills, your interaction with your peers and the tutors, and how you and your group are dealing with the task. Keeping a log will not only help track personal progress and the project's progress, but will also help you when you come to write the final report. At the end of this final report, you will be expected to write one or two paragraphs which reflect on the project and your personal performance.

English must be the language used in the diary. There will be time to discuss the project diaries at the end of the weekly forums and video conferences, so if you have any problems or want to add or change any of the questions then you will have a chance during these communication times. The weekly up-dates to the diary won't take long to fill in and instead of a teacher telling you how things are going you can record and keep abreast of progress yourself.
